Friday 2 June 2017

This could be a meeting excursion or a family day out. Adults will stay with children all through the day. Friends House is opposite Euston Station in London so is easy to get to.

There will be a chance to hear about Quaker peace and social justice work, to visit and find out about the Quaker Library, to visit the Quaker Centre, with its bookshop and worship space, and to learn lots more about Friends House. The day will include stories, talks, activities and worship.

Everybody coming to the day will be assigned to a group of up to 15 people of all ages. All the groups will take part in each of the 5 planned sessions throughout the day. The sessions will be led by different members of Friends House staff and there will be lots of opportunities for questions.

The day's programme starts with refreshments at **10.30am** and ends at **4pm**. At the beginning and end of the day there will be times of worship when everybody will be together.

There is no charge for the day, drinks will be provided during the day and everybody should bring a packed lunch.
