You are warmly invited to attend Britain Yearly Meeting between **4**<sup>th</sup> **and 7**<sup>th</sup> **May 2018** at Friends House in London.

This is *your* Yearly Meeting. Friends of all ages, both members and attenders, are welcome to come. For those over 19, there is no charge, but we ask you to register in advance, so we can send you all the information you need beforehand and help you with any particular access or other requirements you might have. It will also help Friends House prepare for the right number of people and avoid waste. For those under 19 there are programmes suitable for different ages.
