Quakers in Britain are a faith group committed to peace, equality, truth and sustainability. We are keen to work with MPs from all parties on the following issues:

## Democracy

- strengthen processes and culture in Westminster to promote truth, integrity and equity
- protect and promote human rights and civil liberties at home and abroad

## Climate justice

- divert government money away from fossil fuels and towards fair and sustainable solutions to the climate and cost-of-living crises
- make UK-based fossil fuel giants contribute to the international loss and damage fund

#### Peace

- use diplomacy to seek an end to the devastating conflicts in Ukraine and in Israel and Gaza, and work towards a just peace
- redirect government money away from weapons and military and towards the foundations of a safer world, such as climate justice

## Migration

- replace recent migration legislation with a humane, coordinated approach that includes safe and legal routes
- process people's asylum applications more quickly and fairly, providing adequate accommodation and the right to work.
