The John Aves Education Project works in the Dheisheh Palestinian Refugee Camp in the West Bank and is supported by Norwich Quaker Meeting.

The project provides financial support for academically able young people from the refugee camp to study for an undergraduate degree, helping them fulfil their potential and continue their education in their own communities. Gaining a degree in this area with very high unemployment, greatly improves these young people's future employment prospects. The students are selected by a local committee and raise part of the fees themselves .and part of the selection process involves checking that applicants have a clear plan for employment after they have completed their studies.

The project currently supports 10 students from Dheisheh, most studying medicine, dentistry and nursing, at Al Quds University in east Jerusalem.

The QPSW Relief grant will help fund up to 3 additional students obtain degrees.
