The John Aves Education Project Unpaid Fees project is based in Palestine and is supported by Norwich Meeting.

The John Aves Education Project was set up in 2007 to financially support young people from Dheisheh Palestinian Refugee Camp to attend university. As of September 2024 they had provided funding for 87 young people studying subjects ranging from accountancy to medicine.

Since 7 October 2023 life for the students has grown considerably more difficult, with checkpoints in the West Bank closed, universities closed, and learning taking place online. Family incomes have plummeted because there are no tourists or other visitors. Work in Israel by Palestinians is prohibited. The universities and students approached JAEP for help in paying the family share of tuition fees. Unless students pay their fees in full they will not be able to continue their studies or graduate.

The grant will contribute to the unpaid fees for continuing students so that they can register for the next academic year.
