

REDRAD

The Red Radio Fund is a project run by the Prison Chaplaincy at HMP Wandsworth and is supported by Wandsworth Local Meeting.

The project will provide wind up radios to prisoners who spend most of their time locked in their cells, some becoming depressed and ill. A proportion of each batch of radios are reserved for prisoners in solitary confinement and the health unit.

Prisoners are not allowed a TV in their cells. The radios provide a welcome distraction, enabling the men to listen to talk shows and music of their choice as well as foreign broadcasting channels for prisoners from overseas to listen in their own language.
