

Sanctuary Everywhere 2020 appeal



Britain Yearly Meeting's Sanctuary Everywhere programme provides training, guidance and political advocacy support to a network of almost 100 Quaker meetings. These meetings have pledged to create a culture of welcome in their communities for people seeking refuge in Britain, and to challenge the government's hostile environment for migrants.

We need to raise £76,000 to keep this vital Quaker work going in 2020 – will you help?

Sanctuary Everywhere was set up as a two-year project, due to end in December 2019. It has been taken up by a fifth of all Quaker meetings in Britain. We are now seeking a year's extension so that we can keep supporting the crucial work of Sanctuary Meetings and ensure a smooth transition to a more sustainable network.

Right now, migration is as high-profile and divisive an issue as ever, and racially motivated violence is on the rise. Will you help us to support Quaker meetings that are building peace in their communities and making a real difference to individuals and families who have been forced to find a new home?
