This Tools For Self Reliance project is based in Zambia and is supported by Reading Quaker meeting

The project aims to improve the skills and livelihoods of 60 people and enable them to generate a sustainable income. Trainees will be trained to build latrines that will benefit 5,385 pupils at Kabushi A Basic School and make and distribute washable sanitary pads to girl pupils.

The experience acquired by the trainees will give them the skills and tools to set up their own businesses or secure employment. The pupils and school staff be healthier through access to improved sanitation and hand washing facilities, and girls will be less likely to miss school during their periods.
