

## **Our Quaker Way**

## the spiritual discipline of the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers) in Britain

This is the working title for the Book of Discipline to replace Quaker faith & practice.

The committee has structured the content of the draft book as a tree, as shown above. It has spiritual roots nourishing a strong trunk of faith and experience from which grow branches of living communities that can worship, witness and work together.

We want our new book to be as accessible as possible, so we are also describing the tree in words. The detail of the structure may change as we complete the editing of the book.
