



## Britain Yearly Meeting All-together worship (Sunday 28 July, 10:30am to 11:30am)



This will be a huge meeting for worship, taking place across Britain in homes, Quaker Meeting Houses, and other meeting places and at Friends House. We will come together as a single loving, inclusive and all-age community across Britain Yearly Meeting.



Children will join as best suits each local meeting. In Friends House children will join with their parents and doors will remain open for people to come and go as they need. The separate children's programme in Friends House will start from 11am. Local meetings might also arrange to take children out at that time.



How might you show children are welcome in the main meeting room? In Friends House, floor mats and cushions will be provided for children and their carers on the floor in the centre.



It is suggested that boxes of books and quiet toys would be available for quiet self-directed activity. A leaflet attached gives ideas of what might be included in this box. There will be NO guided craft activity, or instructions to do particular things.



Worship will start with a short guided prepared ministry on the screen which will also be available on YouTube. This will be on the theme of "using our senses to centre into stillness". This has been written and will be delivered by a young parent, suitable for all ages.
