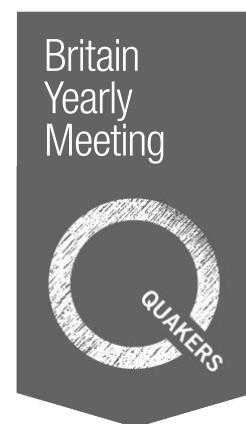

Dear Friends,

We invite you to volunteer and help ensure a successful Yearly Meeting. Help from attending Friends enriches Yearly Meeting and makes the event run seamlessly.
