The Young People's Programme is a residential event for young Quakers aged 11 – 15. Participants are provided with opportunities to engage with and explore Yearly Meeting topics in age appropriate ways.

Supported by the children and young people's work staff, the theme and activities are planned and facilitated by the Young People's Arrangement Committee (four young people appointed at the last Young People's Programme).

The event provides space for worship, exploration of concerns that are of importance to Quakers as well as promising to be thought provoking, exciting and fun.

£205 per person (includes food, accommodation, return train travel to Friends House during the event and coach travel from/to Friends House on Friday and Monday).
