Fred will be joined by a **young Quaker** who identifies as gender non-binary.

This is for those involved in running events with young Quakers aged 11+. Area Meeting CYP Advocates are meeting alongside and will join the conference for some sessions.

The conference provides a networking opportunity for anyone working with young Quakers, including; summer event organisers, committee members, adult volunteers and people working with young Friends in Meetings. Young people involved in planning and running events are welcome to attend.
